We have just come across a small case which seems to have been overlooked. These Japanese lived in Duncan at an address which appears to be 264 White Road. It rather looks as if a small shipment may have been made from this address by Mr. Bossons on November 17th, 1942 but we have no record that shipment was actually made. If it was, apparently the only item sent was a heater and this should leave the following:

These were apparently rented premises, the landlord being variously described as a Mr. Richardson or a Mr. Berry. We doubt if these items were ever of very much value but perhaps Mr. Bossons could look into this.
