This file may be regarded as closed as per my answer to Mr. Alexander's memorandum of June 24th. Any chattels left behind at Paldi are reasonably safe there but we have no record of what still remains after the numerous shipments that have been made. This Japanese did not declare items of any great value and anything that is left such as the old-fashioned writing desk or the mounted deer head, will doubtless be accounted for when our final policy on chattels is decided upon.

MEMORANDUM - From Mr. Green

June 29th, 1943

Re: Foreman URABE

As appears from copy of letter on file of September 29th, the Mayo Brothers Timber Company have stored Japanese belongings in the Hall at Valdi and Mr. Kenyon has been very good in making shipments. They cannot, however, accept responsibility and have no record of what was stored there or what still remains.

This Japanese only declared four items of which it is not clear whether the boxes of tools are identical with or additional to those declared on behalf of Kanpei Osumi. They are probably additional as he applied for one box on November 24th together with some other items, some of which were not declared.

Kanpei Osumi has now received his tools (see his file 10012) some of which he claims were missing.
