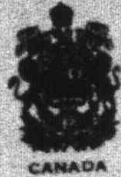

While at this man's residence investigating another matter for the Commission, I was asked to reply to your form letter No. 118, File No. 5517, and explain Miki's inability to meet the premium on his insurance policy now due.

This family consists of Miki, his wife and four children, the eldest of whom is about nine years of age. They have been one of our problem families since coming to this part of the country, and were in receipt of relief from December 1942 to mid-July, 1943.

Due to late season and poor cultivation, earnings from beets this season will amount to around \$122.00, with an additional \$100.00 gathered from harvest work and the like. If no other employment is found for him the family will have to be maintained again this winter. However, we have prospects of placing him in employment which, if successful, will make him self-supporting.

At the present time Miki's earnings are required for family maintenance, and as a consequence, he is unable to meet any kind of indebtedness. He asks that something be done to keep the policy alive, as if we are successful in our endeavor to find him employment for the winter, he may be able to refund the amount advanced to protect his policy.
