PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY File No. 5542 8th December, 1945 OKIMURA, Emika (Mrs. Akira) Reg. No. 06006 The above Japanese declared chattels to be left some CHATTELS: in the house of her father, R. HASHIMOTO, File #2853, and some with Mr. J. Mulligan, a neighbor at Mission. These chattels were inventoried on her father's file and it was then noted by our representative that it was impossible to distinguish ownership between the two. Two shipments were made to her upon receiving requests through the B.C. Security Commission on January 17/44 and February 15/44 and with the co-operation of Mrs. Mulligan the articles requested together with a quantity of personal belongings were sent. Any balance of her chattels remaining after these shipments were sold at auction on February 2, 1944 under the file of her father, File #2853, and in view of the impossibility of distinguishing ownership, adjustments will be left for themselves to make. The chattels of the above Japanese which were apparently included in the list of chattels sent to this office by her father are very well accounted for on his file #2853.) The above Japanese declared a \$5.00 War Savings Certificate. It was not brought under control by the Custodian. Attached heroto is a copy of a letter of complaint from our Supervisor, Mr. Ernst, at Winnipes, relative to a provious shipment to this party, for which we keye received \$46.50 in full settlement. If the stotements in this letter are correct, or anywhere near correct, it is cortainly unfair to have required payment of the shipping and freight charges on worthless goods not requested, the which would not have been sent had Mr.Mulliges been allowed to do the pecking as \$6\$ was requested. It is difficult to understand what objection your Custodian Agent could have had to this arrangement, as similar arrangements have been allowed at other points without any hesitation. Should like to have an explanation of this situation to enable us to judge how much of the charges of this new shipment we can reasonably expect OKIMURA to pay.

We recently applied on behalf of the above named woman for several items of personal effects from the Gustodian and also stated that J, bulligan, the temant, had arranged for the shipment. We have now been informed that the Gustodian would not permit the Bulligans to ship the furniture requested but arranges for the work to be done by the Department itself. In this manner a lot of what the Okimuras term junk was shipped along with the personal affects, which they did not request, and which would not have been sent if the Bulligans had been permitted at arrange for the packing, or at least have been able to submit the list to the Gustodian's representative. We were also informed that part of the old clothes, etc. that were included in the shipment belonged to R. Hashinoto, Reg. No. 18856.

There were a few items which were not included in the shipment, memely, sewing machine, one electric teaster, one box ceremonial dolls, one six pounds from, one fifteen pound from. Custodian release forms are again enclosed covering those items.

The Okimuras also stated that while they were hilled for 1400 pounds about 700 pounds of it were worthless items which were not requested and were not shipped at the Okimuras' responsibility.

Bould you kindly look into this matter because if the above statements are true it would look as though some injustice had been done this family and some adjustment should possibly be made insofar as the freight charges are conserved. The only thing that I can verify is the fact that a lot of worthless stuff was shipped as I want to the house to inspect the goods at the Okimuras' request.
