Mrs. Shina KUMABE resided in House #7, Jap Town #1, Cumberland, B.C. This house was built on land owned by the Canadian Collieries (Dunsmuir) Ltd. This Company paid into this office the sum of \$20.00 to be credited to Mrs. KUMABE. This money was paid by them when they took over the house she had occupied prior to her evacuation. It represented the estimated salvage value of the building.

She declared chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule on file. A shipment of a dresser and a box of kitchenware was made to her on A. 16/43. One stove was not found and 2 beds inventoried by the Custodian are missing. The balance of the chattels were sold at anction for the net sum of \$10.40 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian.
