Do Solemnly Declare that

1. I am solicitor for Etsu Baba, wife of Shunpei Baba, also known as George Baba, who resides at Sea Island in the Province of British Columbia, and am aware of the facts hereinafter declared.
2. I have acted through my agent, Ernest Silverton, Barrister, of 675 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, B.C., and personally, on the instructions of Etsu Baba, in an action in the Supreme Court of British Columbia in Divorce and Matrimonial Causes, No. B-158/42, petitioned for restitution of conjugal rights.
3. The said Court action has now been settled and in connection with the settlement thereof Mr. George E. McCrossan, Barrister and Solicitor, acting as solicitor for Shunpei Baba, undertook the payment of the costs for the services of myself and my agent with respect to the said cause of action in the amount of \$125.00, and the said Shunpei Baba is justly and truly indebted to myself in the said sum of \$125.00 after making all just discounts.
4. It has been arranged between the solicitors that upon Mrs. Baba returning to her husband's home the funds for payment of this indebtedness of the said Shunpei Baba from the said Shunpei Baba, will be obtained by Mr. McCrossan and he will pay the same to myself.
5. This Declaration was filed by myself to secure the payment of the said sum of \$125.00 and to protect my interest therein in the event that the aforementioned arrangement between solicitors should not be completed.
