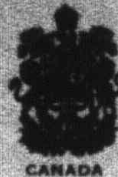

Chokichi IGARASHI died at Sandon, B.C. on May 17, 1943. His file reveals no relatives.

The deceased declared no assets and no liabilities to the Custodian but, on January 31, 1945, articles identified as belonging to IGARASHI were sold at Surrey Auction No.9 for a net amount of \$8.27.

A claim was filed against the estate of the deceased by the British Columbia Security Commission for \$80.00 to cover the cost of burial of the deceased. A cheque for \$8.27, being the balance in this account, was mailed to the Department of Labour on October 4, 1946, to apply against this claim, as the R. C. M. P. report on this man indicates no next-of-kin.
