In reply to your letter of the 18th instant, we beg to advise you that Mrs. Hirakida's file shows that her only asset is a small amount of household chattels.

Sun Life Policy No. 2,261,739, 20 year endowment, maturing September 15th, 1958. Cash surrender value, August, 1943 -- \$123.15.
Premium on this Policy is in arrears.

Liabilities: Home Bros. -- \$1.00.

Our file indicates that Mr. Hirakida sold his fishing boat "K.K.", on May 8th, 1943, for the sum of \$913.25, and these funds were paid directly to him, prior to his internment.
