CHATELS:

The above, who registered with the Custodian on April 22/42 and was evacuated on June 1/42, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. Nevertheless on Nov. 8/42 he sent us a J.P. form declaring 1 double bed and 1 box of books in the store house of the B. C. Packers, Vancouver Cannery, Eburne, B.C. On Sept. 22/43 he sent us a Custodian Release for one bed complete with spring and mattress and one trunk with the name "T. MAYEDE" printed on it. (The name of the father of the above is Tokujiro MAYEDE and he lives in Japan). These were shipped to him on Nov. 17/43 by the B. C. Security Commission.

On Dec. 16/42 Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, inventoried at the Vancouver Cannery warehouse, List #86, and moved to storage at the Community Hall, Vancouver Cannery, 1 mattress, parcelled, and 1 carton. These were shipped to the above on Nov. 17/43 along with the bed and trunk.

On Feb. 23/45 more goods were found in the name of the above and inventoried by Custodian agent, Mr. G. M. Harris, List #13, and on June 11/45 still more goods were found at the Vancouver Cannery and inventoried by Custodian agent Mr. G.M. Harris, List #E13. The goods on both List 13 and List E13 were sold at auction for the net sum of \$19.71 and this sum was credited to the account of the above with this office.

The file reveals that the above owned no specified articles.
