PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 22/42 and was evacuated on May 19/42, declared no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia.

He was an unmarried student of 16, who had formerly lived at 285 Heatley Ave., Vancouver, but at the time of his declaration, he was at the Acme Cannery, Sea Island.

A net, #4, tagged with the name of Takashi KOYANAGI was sold to the Imperial Cannery (owned by B.C. Packers Ltd.), from the Terra Nova Cannery on March 3/43, for the sum of \$175.00. This item appears on an undated net statement from the B. C. Packers Ltd. covering a total sales value of \$1242.00. The nearest name we have to Takashi KOYANAGI is Tadashi KOYANAGI and the proceeds from sale of this net were credited to his account. However as he declared no nets and did not reply to our letter of Sept. 10/43, enquiring as to whether he had left any chattels here, it does not appear that this net belonged to him. We have therefore instructed the Accounting Department to hold these funds until the proper owner of the net can be identified.

The file reveals no specified articles owned by the above.

No property interests other than those mentioned are found on this file.

On B. C. Packers' statement in the amount of \$1,242.00, undated, there appears the following item:

"Takashi KOYANAGI, his #4 ex Terra Nova Cannery - \$175.00"

The nearest name we have to this spelling is Tadashi KOYANAGI - a student of sixteen who states definitely he had no nets to declare. There are two other T. Koyanagi's, both declaring nets at the Terra Nova Cannery and this net must belong to one of them, but unless we can get a description of same, the \$175.00 will have to be placed in the Suspense Account. Would you, therefore, endeavour to get the full description of this net from the B. C. Packers.
