

June 15/42. 1 trunk, 3 boxes effects, 2 tubs, 1 cart. effects, and 1 cedar chest. (8 pieces).

July 25/42. 1 sewing machine and 1 wash tub full of effects, pots and pans etc. (2 pieces).

Balance left in the house are 1 small cast heater, 1 donkey stove, 4 chairs, 4 old tables, 1 cupboard and 4 old bed frames. These being of very little value have been left in the home.
