GENERAL SUMMARY

File 5756.

Kiyonobu NISHIMURA

Reg. No. 09463.

This 46-year old Japanese-National Millworker from Woodfibre, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 25th April, 1942. He was evacuated on the 16th September, 1942.

His wife, Michiye, resides in Japan.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Personal Property: This evacuee declared no chattels, but on June 11/43, he signed a Custodian Release Form asking for a few kitchen utensils, which he left at K. Kusano's (File 9587) house, Hammond, B. C. These were shipped to him, as per Bill of Lading, dated Mar. 10/44, in B. C. Security Commission's file records.

Specified Articles: None.

Bills Receivable: This evacuee declared a debt of \$50.00 owing to him by T. Inouye, File 8202, but later (Apr. 7/45) reported that this debt had been paid in full.

Refund of 1% wage deductions made during period, January/June, 1941, was received, and credited, to this account in the sum of \$5.60. This amount was remitted to Nishimura on Jan. 10/44, closing his account.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: War Savings Certificates (4 @ \$10.00) declared to be in owner's possession, did not come under the administration of this office.

Bank Accounts: None.


Life Insurance: This evacuee declared a Sun Life policy (No. 2,105,496) for \$1,000.00 (beneficiary, wife, Michiye, in Japan). This remained in his possession, and did not come under the administration of this office.

Liabilities: There are no claims recorded in this file.

We have received through the Security Commission copy of your Custodian Release of June 11th asking for the following items.

(all the following, unpacked and in a partition--somewhat like a coal-bin structure--on eastern side of the cellar.)

Unpacked kitchen utensils--(Oval dish-pan; roast pan with cover; 1 big mixing bowl; 1 mixing bowl with grinding grooves inside; porcelain soup bowls; rice bowls; all dishes, and all other cooking utensils.)

You did not declare anything to the Custodian and further enquiries from you at Hastings Park elicited the fact that you had only one bed in the protected area which you did not think worth declaring. Our records for Kiujiro Kusano do not show anything belonging to you left with him.

As, however, the above items are of no great importance, we shall go ahead and arrange shipment unless we hear promptly to the contrary from Kiujiro Kusano to whom we are sending a copy of this letter.
