We wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 18th ult. regarding a claim against the above party for \$33.00 by G. Kawahara. It is noted that TSUJIMOTO states that this amount is owing to him by Kawahara.

Reference to the registration form of TSUJIMOTO on file, dated April 25/42, indicates plainly under the heading of "Liabilities Personal Debts - \$33.00 owing to Mr. G. Kawahara, Chemainus, B.C." This is a declaration by TSUJIMOTO, and naturally we concluded that he owed Kawahara this amount. We do not find, however, that Kawahara has filed a claim for any amount against him, but instances of this nature often occur. We shall, therefore, assume that Kawahara owes TSUJIMOTO \$33.00 and shall file the claim against him, notifying him accordingly.

We are enclosing herewith our official cheque No. 1326 for \$5.98, in favour of Masao TSUJIMOTO - this being a refund by the Provincial Govt. on account of wage deductions in 1941. Kindly have him acknowledge receipt.
