Dear Madam:

We have your letter of December 28 and have interviewed the Official Administrator who will put this matter in hand as soon as possible. It will take a little time to get it put in order.

We believe that you have only two children, Kameo and Miyo. Are there any others? Possibly it would be the wish of these children that you should get the whole benefit of your husband's Estate, but as Miyo is not yet 21 years old she cannot lawfully give her consent. Kameo can do so however and if it is his and your wish that you receive his share please get him to write us a letter stating that he gives to you his share in his father's Estate. This will be enough in the meantime. Later on we can arrange a proper form for him to sign which will make this arrangement effective as far as he is concerned.

Is Miyo living with you? We have not got her address. Is she self-supporting or do you keep her? If she is being maintained by you we could possibly arrange to pay you some or all of her share of the revenue for that purpose.

Please give us the answers to the above questions.
