2: Further enquiries were made at the Houthledge Motors, Mission, B.C. H.T. Kraemer, book-keeper was interviewed, and stated that on April, 23rd, 1942, T. Okabe had been into the Garage and paid Houthledge Motors the remaining amount of \$222.00 owing on lien held by the Western Finance Co. At the time Kraemer stated he had asked Okabe what he had done with his car and he stated that he had lent it to a friend. The serial number of this car was taken from Garage records and is as follows, 018V814.

3: Further enquiries was made at the B.C. Police Office in an effort to locate transfer of license record, but none could be found at that office.


