Dear Madam:-

Thank you for your letter of February 6th asking for some Japanese festival dolls for your children. The Security Commission are responsible for the shipment of effects to evacuated Japanese and will not, we believe, agree to the shipment of such items as these. We do not, however, wish to disappoint you and are immediately writing to the tenants of your property, being Mr. H. D. Arnett and asking him to post these to you direct.

Turning to your query about the missing chattels we think that everything is in order. The locked room has not been opened or tampered with while the articles left in Mr. Arnett's care will be safe. We will, however, have a complete recheck made when time permits.

The above Japanese has asked for her small daughters' Japanese festival dolls. We do not feel justified in incurring any expense in making a shipment of this sort but if it would not be too much trouble, perhaps you could arrange to post them c.o.d. to her at c/o Merlin Shields, Diamond City, Alberta. She writes as follows:

"They are all supposed to be in one place on the floor on the right hand side of the room as you go in. I wish you would send them out as soon as possible as they have very little to do in this cold prairie climate in such small dwelling as ours. Besides, the Japanese Girls Doll Festival Day is March 3rd and so I wish I could have them sent by then and help me to cheer up the children. They are contained in small wooden and some of them in paper boxes, the whole set being piled up in one place on the floor on the right hand side near the wall. I will pay all expenses so please favour me with my offer for the sake of my little ones."

If you feel you cannot spare the time or trouble to make this shipment, it cannot be helped.
