TANOUYE registered with the Custodian on April 22/42 and was evacuated on April 25/42. He signed a yellow "No property card stating he owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: On May 22/42 the account of TANOUYE was credited with the sum of \$49.01, being a refund of National Defense Tax for 1942.

His account has also been credited with the sum of \$3.40 being a refund of 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1941.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on his file.


