Our file shows that the deceased owned no property  
and had no assets. Her husband's file shows that he is the  
owner of one Victory Bond, valued at \$50.00, also the owner  
of a 1-storey, 3-room, wooden frame movable dwelling house on  
Annacis Island. Before evacuation he sold five nets and a  
fishing boat. He originally owned seven nets, which according  
to his own appraisal, were worth \$550.00
