PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: KICHIKAWA, Kiroji - Reg. No. 10604.

The above named signed a declaration to the Custodian to the effect that he had no property of any kind, on April 23, 1942 and was evacuated on October 19, 1942.

CHATELS: In February 1943 KICHIKAWA requested that a Brown tool box stored with the Custodian be shipped to him. He did not indicate where this box was stored. It appears that the Sisters of the Atonement of 385 East Cordova Street were holding the box. Shipment was made in March 1943, as per letter of December 10, 1946 from the Sisters of the Atonement.

This file reveals no other property than that mentioned above.

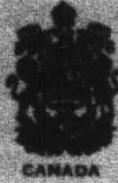
