My chattels list 59 of 26H June 1942.
At the time of removal of these chattels an ice cream machine and a pool table were being cared for by the Navy for their station here at the Scottish Canadian Cannery. Receipt by Petty Officer Chas. Reid is enclosed.

Just by chance last night I learned that the Navy had received a sudden call to move and I immediately demanded the return of the above mentioned articles and was told that they neither had the time nor the men to do this.

I have arranged to loan the ice cream machine to M. David who has removed it and now has possession and I have his receipt for same.

To remove the pool table will require three or four men with double handling by hand dolly and truck after dismantling the table and will cost fifteen dollars or more.

In the meantime I will try and loan to some one else so as to avoid this cost as I have a few requests but if I have to remove this the cost of same should be carried by the Navy.

This Navy building is owned by the Canadian Fishing Company and there is a watchman on the job but I consider it wiser to have this table taken from where it is as soon as possible.

Should I make a loan of this to another party I will insist that insurance is carried by them.

I have received notification from A.S. Matthew & Company to the effect that Michigan Fire Policy No. 6012283, covering for \$500.00 on a confectionery store, in the name of Yasu Takagaki, falls due for renewal on on February 25th.

On checking up Mrs. Yasu Takagaki's file I found nothing in it concerning this Confectionery Store but on referring to her son's file -- Masao Takagaki (No. 3867) I find that he did declare this property. He described it as a frame bungalow used as a store and built on land belonging to the A.B.C. Packing Company at Steveston. Also he gives a list of equipment in that store.

I telephoned A.S. Matthew & Company to obtain further particulars about this policy, but learned nothing further except that the coverage was on the building itself and it was described as being on ~~the building~~ belonging to the Phoenix Cannery. *property.*

At your first opportunity and sometime before the expiry date (February 25th) you might find out from the Phoenix Cannery just what the situation is with respect to this Confectionery Store.

Does the Cannery consider it part of their property or do they recognize the Japanese as being owner of same. Also, is there any equipment still left in the Confectionery Store, and what do you consider the insurable value of the place and contents, if any, to be.
