"Please answer me to this matter at your earliest conveniences. Thank You."

We would appreciate your comments on this letter in order that we may be enabled to reply to Miss Oye. In your reply please show the original cost of the machine and the separate payments which have been made to you up to the present time.

Replying to your letter of the 23rd of July, 1943, regarding the above named. We note that you say: "With your co-operation we have done everything we can to locate this account without success."

We cannot quite understand how you have not been able to locate this party as she is living at Greenwood, B.C., and we have communicated with her about the machine, and in fact we wrote you on April 6th, 1943 conveying her reply to one of our communications. We also note from yours of the 7th instant that the machine had reverted to you prior to the date of her registering with the Custodian and prior to the date of her evacuation. Under these circumstances the Custodian will not take any action regarding the disposal of this machine, but we note that Miss OYE has already paid a considerable proportion of the original cost and we suggest that you give her every consideration when you finally decide as to the disposal of the machine. Incidentally our records do not show that you have communicated with her at any time. If you were to do so perhaps she might see her way to arrange some settlement.

Please send us the usual cancellation of all claims with regard to this machine.

We are enclosing a copy of our letter to Miss OYE.
