This file reveals that the above owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: When the above registered with the Custodian she signed a yellow "No property" card stating that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C. Nevertheless a reference to the file of her husband reveals that he declared chattels left at a Pacific Coast Cannery House. Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, on July 4/42, inventoried goods marked with the name of the above at House #15, Pacific Coast Cannery, as per list #82 on file, and removed them to central storage. A few items were left in the house as not worth moving and these have been abandoned. The remaining chattels were sold at auction for the net sum of \$14.73 and this sum credited to the account of the above with this office. On March 26/45 a Custodian cheque in the sum of \$6.56 was remitted to the above, which she had requested through the B.C.S.C. This was the total balance of both Mr. and Mrs. HONDA at that time. The \$8.17 now standing to her credit with this office was the proceeds of subsequent sales.
