The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 23rd, 1942, and was evacuated on April 25th, 1942, declared no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area of British Columbia.

However on March 15/44, the Mother Superior of the Catholic Mission at Greenwood gave us a list of those who had left beds at the Catholic Mission at Steveston, and included in this list was the name of the above. When these beds were removed from this mission, one was found tagged with the name "T. OGAWA". It was in reply to our query as to what this initial stood for that we received the reply from the Mother Superior giving us the full names of all those who had left beds at the Mission. This bed was sold at Steveston auction No. 9 for the net sum of \$4.26, which amount was credited to the account of the above.

The file reveals that the above owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

We enclose herewith our cheque in the sum of \$4.26,  
which is the total amount of your credit with this office.

It is noted that when you made your declaration to the  
Custodian on April 23rd, 1942, you declared no property of any  
kind whatsoever in the protected area of British Columbia. However  
on January 18th, 1944, a complete bed and spring, identified as  
being your property, was removed from the Catholic Mission at Steveston  
and sold for the net amount of \$4.26.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property  
of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the  
Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the  
cheque, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience  
in replying.
