Yajiro Shiho lived at Steveston, B.C. and died
intestate on June 11, 1941, leaving surviving him the following:

Yasuo SHIHO, Reg. #04152, Widow. File 5970;
Seichi SHIHO, Reg. #04200, Age. 34, File 5971;
Mitsui, SHIHO, Reg. #04169, Age. 25, File 4878.
Marie SHIHO, Reg. #05456, Age. 23, File 5886. ✓
Ichiro SHIHO, Reg. #05631, Age. 21, File 4872.
Hisashi SHIHO, Reg. #15793, Age. 19, File 15619.

Marie died at Bridge River, November 6, 1944. ✓

Administration was applied for and on October 9,
1941 Letters of Administration were granted by the Supreme Court
of British Columbia to Yasuo Shiho of Steveston, B.C. the lawful widow
and one of the heirs at law.

The Custodian file discloses ASSETS of deceased
as follows:

1. Lot 14, Blk. 2, Sec. 10, B.M., R7W, Map 249, D.S.V.,
situated on 1st Ave., in Steveston. This is a vacant
lot valued by the appraiser at \$100.00.
2. Boat "Shanrock" sold in February 13, 1943. Net proceeds
of \$178.88.
3. Boat "I.S." sold October 20, 1942. Net proceeds \$1777.00.

Liabilities - None.

The file indicates that these boats were not listed as
assets in the inventory when application was made for Administration but
there appears to be no doubt of their ownership.



A Custodian No Property card was signed on behalf of Marie Shiho, who was mentally deficient, by her Mother, Yasue Shiho, and no assets belonging to her have come under the control of the Custodian. She died at Bridge River on November 8, 1944.

Had she lived, Marie Shiho would have been entitled to a share in the Estate of her father, Iajiro, who predeceased her. Since she died single and predeceased her mother, any share to which she would be entitled goes to her mother. Yasue Shiho, the widow, will, therefore, receive one-third of the Estate together with Marie's share which, if the records are correct, would be one-sixth of two-thirds of the net Estate.
