



re: Mr. Y. WAKISAKA - \$176.40

Tuesday the writer called your office by phone relative to the above claim. It had been presented to Yasuo WAKISAKA, Registration No. 00846, by this office some considerable while ago and he had replied definitely denying the account. In advising your office this, we ascertained from your Representative on the phone that the initial "Y" in the name of your list did not refer to "Yasuo" but to "Yusujiro", and that you had been informed that Yusujiro had returned to Japan--this latter our records confirm.

Your report stated that the patient's name was "Takashi" and that he was fifteen years old when in hospital in 1936. You understood that he was a son of Yusujiro.

Apparently, therefore, the account is against Yusujiro WAKISAKA and as he has no assets here so far as we know and as he is now in Japan, the prospects of our collecting the account are nil. We will, therefore, cancel the account as against Yasuo WAKISAKA and discontinue any further action in regard to Yusujiro WAKISAKA.
