The Evacuee's declaration of August 3, 1942 revealed that the Imperial Cannery, Steveston, B. C. owed the Evacuee \$50.00, approximately, for mending nets in 1941. As no reply was received from the Imperial Cannery, the Evacuee was written to on February 17, 1945 stating that the Custodian assumed that the Evacuee attempted a settlement with Imperial Cannery in the meantime. As the Evacuee did not reply to this letter we took for granted that our assumption was correct.


There are no other property interests declared or revealed on this file.

June 21, 1946

On rechecking the Moneys Owning to Kikumatsu OYE, our telephone conversation with Mr. Eric Low, of the Imperial Cannery, Steveston, informed us that they had no Servicing Department in their Cannery in Steveston. The Japanese serviced their own nets and the Cannery only sold them new nets or twine, therefore, no claim will be considered by them.


LIABILITY SUMMARY

There is a claim lodged against the Evacuee by Kamejira MATSURA in the amount of \$2.70. Receiving no reply to our letter of February 17, 1945 to the Evacuee, the Custodian wrote to Kamejira MATSURA on March 27, 1945 stating that we had received no answer to our letter and as the Custodian had no funds to the credit of Kikumatsu OYE nothing further would be done by the Custodian for the collection of this debt. The Evacuee's address was given Kamejira MATSURA in hopes that an adjustment of the debt could be made.
