Dear Madam:

On the Dyke at Queensboro, New Westminster there is a small dwelling on logs lying on land controlled by Low Sing. Mr. Hosumi SASAKI, whose mother Taki SASAKI owned at one time certain other property at this location, tells us that the house in question was your property.

If this is so will you kindly advise whether you had any lease agreement with the said Low Sing in regards to protecting your equity when you or whoever was occupying the house vacated it.

If the above Chinese claims the ownership of this house, being on his land, in order that the Custodian may help you it will be necessary for you to give us information in regards to your equity, such as when you moved the house on to his property, what written or verbal arrangements, if any, were made by you for its removal when the house was placed on Low Sing's property. Have you paid any ground rent in the last two or three years?

We should like a full history by return mail.
