CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 24/42 and was evacuated on May 5/42, declared five nets, cork and lead lines to the value of \$420.00, located at the Pacific Coast Cannery Net House, Steveston. This declaration however is unsigned by KITADE and the information was given by his mother, Sute KITADE, File 1385. On the same date as he made his declaration, he signed a yellow "No property" card.

Only one net was inventoried by Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson on Jan. 4/43 at this cannery. This was sold to Nelson Bros. for the sum of \$35.00, which sum was credited to the account of the above. On August 2/43 we received from the A.B.C. Packing Co. a cheque in the sum of \$55.00 which included the sum of \$20.00 for web found in the name of "Y. KITADE" at the Good Hope Cannery, Rivers Inlet. This sum was credited to the account of the above, as he was the only man of this name we could find. We wrote the A.B.C. Packing Co. Ltd. on July 30/43 for further identification of this man but no further particulars were given in their letter of August 2/43. We also wrote to the above on May 1/46 and again on May 18/46 inquiring whether he had ever fished at the Good Hope Cannery and had left any nets there. No reply has been received to these letters. No other nets declared by the above were found by the Custodian but it is noted that he sold two nets himself direct to the cannery for the sum of \$145.00.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

MONEYS
RECEIVABLE:

In February, 1943, the account of the above was credited with the sum of \$3.00 being a refund from the B.C. Electric Railway Co. Ltd., security deposit for light.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The Custodian's agent found only one net in your name and this was appraised and sold for the sum of \$35.00.
