Further to our letter of June 23rd last and yours of June 28th in which you advised that your cheque for \$581.10 had been sent to Calgary to be forwarded to your assured. We have now received a copy of letter from the B. C. Security Commission at Lethbridge which reads in part as follows:

"We would like to point out at this time that a letter on July 20th from the Treasury Branch shows that the above party was forwarded \$581.10 from a Life Insurance Policy with the Manufacturers Life. This is incorrect as Mr. Kanegawa still holds the Insurance Policy in his possession, and while he was advised that the said \$581.10 was the cash surrender value of the policy, the policy has not been surrendered, and no money has been received by Mr. Kanegawa from the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company."
