GENERAL SUMMARY

Yoshitaro KADA, Deceased.

Yoshitaro Kada died at Essendale, B. C. on November 7, 1946. He is survived by his widow, Fude, file #9516, and four minor children.

* The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian but on June 5, 1942, we were advised by Walter A. Jacklin & Company that Yoshitaro KADA held one share in Associated Cleaners and Dyers Ltd., which company is in liquidation. W. A. Jacklin & Company were advised on November 26, 1946, of the death of the shareholder and requested to make all future distribution of funds to this office.

We were also advised by the Crown Life Insurance Company that Mr. and Mrs. Kada were insured under their Policy #207967. However, it is learned, from a telephone conversation with that Company, that this policy lapsed for non-payment of premium on January 23, 1946.

A claim was filed by the Department of Labour for recovery of the sum of \$80.31 from the Estate of the deceased to cover funeral expenses paid by the Department in connection with his burial. They were advised on November 20, 1946, that no funds were available at this time but that sufficient funds might be derived from the share held by the deceased in Associated Cleaners & Dyers Ltd.

The sum of \$1.93 was credited to the account of Yoshitaro Kada in this office from the sale of chattels removed from 556 Powell Street. It was found, however, that Yoshitaro Kada had never lived at that address but that Fude Kada had lived there prior to her evacuation. The credit was, therefore, transferred to the account of Fude Kada and the funds forwarded to her.

A report was made to the widow of our administration of her husband's affairs.

We regret to hear of the death of your late husband, Yoshitaro KADA. We have reviewed his file with the Custodian, having in mind the possibility of having his Estate administered. We find, however that apart from a notice from the Crown Life Insurance Company relative to policy #207967, which we are advised lapsed for non-payment of premium on January 23, 1946, and a notice from Walter A. Jacklin & Company, dated June 5, 1942, indicating that your late husband held one share in Associated Cleaners and Dyers Ltd., the Custodian has no knowledge of any Estate to be administered.

We understand that the Associated Cleaners and Dyers Ltd. is being liquidated but we have no information as to the possible value of the one share held by your husband. We are also given to understand that it may be two years before the winding up of this Company is completed. If and when any funds are forthcoming in this regard you will be advised.

In the meantime, the Department of Labour, in a letter dated November 18, 1946, has made a claim for recovery of the sum of \$80.31 from the estate of Yoshitaro KADA to cover the funeral expenses paid by the Department in connection with his death. It may be, therefore, that any funds derived from this share in Associated Cleaners and Dyers Ltd. will be used to satisfy this funeral claim.
