





Your letter of August 11, 1947, in regard to the above claim has been received.

From the information you have given; that is, that the person concerned was reported to have been repatriated, it would seem that your claim must be against Miss Tomoe FUJINO, Japanese Registration No. 02704, who returned to Japan on August 2, 1946. The statement attached to refund of 1945 Income Tax made to Miss FUJINO gives her file number as 999 and account number as 3469. Possibly these references would enable you to discover if she is the person referred to in your claim of \$98.25. If your claim is against Miss FUJINO, we are sorry to inform you that this office has no knowledge of any assets belonging to her.

On the other hand if the name "Tomoe FUJINO" given in your letter is correct, it would seem that this claim must be against Mr. Tomoe FUJINO, Japanese Registration No. 07072. Mr. Tomoe FUJINO in 1941 was a fisherman at Deep Bay, B. C. Following his evacuation he went to Coldstream, B. C., and the most recent address we have for this man is, c/o The Hamilton Golf and Country Club, Hamilton, Ontario. No funds are standing to the credit of this man in Custodian Trust Account, and no property known to belong to him is under the control of this office.
