

I, Jiro SASAKI of Welling, Alberta, do solemnly declare

1. That I owned a Westinghouse Mantel Model 440A radio, Serial No. 188149, and have personal knowledge of the facts herein declared.
2. That I had in my possession and control at Clayburn, B.C. a Westinghouse Mantel radio, Model 440A, Serial No. 188149.
3. On the 11th day of March, 1942, I delivered the said radio to the Royal Columbian Mounted Police, and obtained a receipt therefor.
4. That I have made a most diligent search for the said receipt in all repositories where such receipt might be. I have not found the same and I verily believe that the said receipt has been lost beyond recovery and destroyed.
5. That I have not in any way dealt with the said receipt or papers relating to the said radio, and have not pledged or hypothecated the same or lodged the receipt with any person, firm or corporation as security.
6. The sole reason for the non-production of the receipt is that it has been lost or accidentally destroyed.
7. That I have been informed that my radio has been sold for the sum of \$17.45
8. That I, Jiro SASAKI, the owner, am therefore, now entitled to the proceeds of such sale, amounting to \$17.45.

AND I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing it to be true and knowing it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the Canada Evidence Act.
