The forty-five unredeemable Panific Co-sperative Union Shares belonging to your father have no redemption value at this time but will continue to draw interest at the rate of 15 per sense. Dear Sire Your file has come under review and we take this opportunity of giving you a brief summary of our administration of your affairs. When registering with the Custodian you made a declaration to the effect that the only assets owned by you in the Protected Area were a Ear Savings Certificate which was not brought under control by the Gustodian, and a 1937 Ford truck. Your truck having been transferred by you to the Pacific Co-eperative Union for sale prior to your registration with this office, was released to them. The Pacific Co-operative Union sold the truck for the sum of \$400.00. and remitted thus sum to this office, less \$21.79 which was your debit balance according to their records. On their statement when remitting these funds, it is noted that interest on a United Parmers! Co-operative Union shere in the execut of 800 was also included and credited to your account. This share was actually your father's, and the interest therefore should have been credited to him. However, as all your funds have been remitted to you, we are leaving the adjustment of this to be made between yourselves. The Pacific Co-operative Union filed a claim in the emount of \$44.30 against you covering repairs to your truck. This matter had been overlooked by them owing to an error in posting to their ledgers. It was referred to you and in accordance with a letter received from you and your father on the 12th December, 1943, settlement of this claim was made from your father's account. It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the Protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we are enclosing a stemped addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
