This file reveals that Yoshitomo MUKAI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

> MUKAI registered with the 'ustodian on April 20/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 17/4. He signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: MUKAI surrendered two cameras to the R.C.M.P. on March 11/42. These were released to the B.C.S.C. for shipment to MUKAI on Jan. 13/44.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: His account was credited with the sum of \$4.79, being a refund of 15 wage deductions for the first six months of 1941. This is his only credit with the Custodian.

Mr. Yoshimatsu MUKAI, deceased, father of Yoshitomo MUKAI, has a credit of \$446.91 with the Custodian. However there are claims totalling \$540.11 against the estate, so there will not be any funds coming to Yoshitomo MUKAI from the estate of his father.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
