CHATTEL SUMMARY

RE: Shintaro SHIMIZU (Deceased)

When the above registered with the Custodian on April 20/42 he signed a "No property" card stating he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C. He was a carpenter employed by Nelson Bros. Fisheries Ltd. at Steveston. He lived with his mother at House #11, Pacific Coast Cannery. At the time he registered with the Custodian he was 23 years of age and unmarried. He died on or about August 1st, 1943.

On Oct. 11/42, SHIMIZU wrote asking us to send him 2 boxes of tools and Japanese gramophone records. The tools, 1 cloths bag (containing clothing) and 1 bamboo clothes box, were shipped to his mother at Greenwood on Oct. 18/42 on Custodian release on her file, 1027, dated Oct. 14/42. The records were not found at this time so were not included in the shipment. They were found eventually in a box with other goods belonging to his mother, and were sold at Steveston auction No. 39, on Nov. 2/45, and the proceeds from their sale credited to her account.

On June 26/42 we removed from #11, Pacific Coast Cannery to our warehouse in the name of the above, 2 paper parcels, a wooden case and a battery. The battery was taken by the Navy. In his letter of Jan. 29/43 SHIMIZU asks us to sell this battery, but as the Navy had had to replace the battery with a new one costing them \$14.00 for his vessel, it is very doubtful if the Navy would pay for one which was now useless. The goods contained in the parcels and wooden case were sold at auction as per Chattel List #50 on file, for the net sum of \$16.75, and this amount credited to his account.

On Dec. 28/42 SHIMIZU wrote and asked to have his keg of soybean sauce shipped to his mother at Greenwood. This was not shipped as it had been destroyed as being unfit for shipment.

On Jan. 29/43 he wrote again asking us to sell 5 1/2 cords of wood stored at House #11, and the storage battery. The wood could not be found. It had probably been stolen as the winter of 1943 was very cold and wood was scarce. The battery was taken over by the Navy as stated above.

In his letter of Jan. 29/43, he also included a net statement. These nets and lines were declared on his mother's file, No. 1027. As the nets were untagged, the proceeds from their sale, namely \$22.00, was put into Net Suspense Account. After getting list of nets from SHIMIZU, these were identified and the money for them transferred from Suspense Account to the account of the above.

In our memo to Miss Girard of March 22/46 we asked that the proceeds from the account of the above, including household goods and nets, be transferred to the account of his mother, File 1027. This was done on March 27/46.
