
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

The above who registered with the Custodian on April 20th, 1942, and was interned on May 16/42, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. However he sent us a \$5.00 War Savings Certificate asking that it be cashed and the funds sent to him at Camp. On June 22/43 Custodian cheque in the sum of \$4.07, being redemption value of his War Savings Certificate, was remitted to the above at Angler Internment Camp, and his acknowledgment of receipt of same was received in this office on July 5th, 1943.

No other property of any kind belonging to the above was brought under the administration of the Custodian.

His sister, Hideko MASAGO, in a letter just received, indicates that there are War Savings Certificates registered in the name of Yukio Masago, but she doesn't state where these certificates are. We have asked her, if she is holding them, to send them to this office.

Dorothy Hideko Masago desires the Evacuation Section to send her the cash surrender value of War Saving Certificates in her own name, together with the cash surrender value of her brother's War Savings Certificates.

If you are holding War Saving Certificates for your internee and if there are no claims on file against him, kindly have him paraded and ascertain whether or not it is his wish that his certificates be cancelled and that proceeds be sent to his sister.


