

"In reply to your letter with enclosed copy of claims letter from the Custodian re the above man I have had a personal interview with him and while he acknowledges these claims, he says that he has no money to make settlement."

"The family, consisting of his wife and six children(eldest 13 years of age) are on supplementary maintenance. KANDA, himself, works as a janitor on the Commission payroll at 22½ per hour. He retains \$15.00 per month as a reward for labour and the balance of his monthly earnings is budgeted against the family's maintenance."
