

Mr. Kanda admitted owing both of these claims, but stated that he had no funds with which to pay them. The creditors were advised of this and given Mr. Kanda's address on December 2, 1943. No further action was taken by the Custodian.

However, a Marconi mantel radio, which was turned over to the A.C.M.P. by Yoshio Kanda's son, Mutsumi, a minor, was sold in the amount of \$31.93 on March 23, 1944, and this money is being placed in Custodian Suspense Account until such time as Yoshio Kanda produces a receipt for this radio.

A refund of B. C. Electric Railway Co. Ltd., security deposit for light, in the amount of \$4.46, was received in July, 1945. As this amount is too small to divide between the above two claims, we are sending a cheque for this amount to Mr. Kanda today.

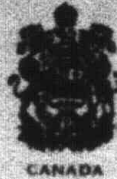

"The family, consisting of his wife and six
children(eldest 13 years of age) are on supplemen-
tary maintenance. KANDA, himself, works as a
janitor on the Commission payroll at 22½¢ per hour.
He retains \$15.00 per month as a reward for labour
and the balance of his monthly earnings is budgeted
against the family's maintenance."
