The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file.

A claim was filed against Kamekichi KAWASHIMA by M. Furuya Company in the amount of \$3.30. The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses paid by the Commission for the burial of the deceased. They were advised by this office on September 20, 1943, that there were no funds available from which to pay their claim.
