We have had a letter from Mitsutaro Nakane's daughter in regard to the rent money due in connection with her father's property and we then received a further letter stating that a Mr. McNair had deposited the money in the Royal Bank of Canada for Mitsutaro Nakane's account. This property is known as Lot 28, Section 2, Block 3 North, Range 7 West, Map 963 and our records show that this property was rented to Mr. McNair for \$100.00 per year and that he in turn rented the house only and a small ground patch to a Mr. Farris for \$8.00 per month, which means that Mr. McNair got the farm for \$4.00 per year. We have never received a copy of this lease and a renewal should not be given without referring the matter to this office. Would you kindly advise Mr. McNair that no payment should be made to the credit of Japanese in any Bank and that all rental monies must be sent to us.

We are today writing the Royal Bank of Canada, Steveston, asking them to inform us of any payments which appear to be rentals.
