This sum was credited to Shin MNDO, However as it seemed to belong to Shigeharu rather than Shin, we wrote to both the brothers and have now received a meply from Shigeharu stating that the range was a McClary and was owned by him. We have therefore transferred the \$50.00 to the credit of Shigeharu.
