GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 6096

RE: Shin ENDO, Reg. No. 11776

Shin ENDO registered with the Custodian on April 19/42 and was evacuated on April 28/42. He signed a yellow "No property" card stating he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area.

Shin ENDO and his brother Shigeharu ENDO, File 5051, both worked at the Celtic Cannery. Shin ENDO was a single man, but Shigeharu was married and did declared household goods left at the Cannery. On Nov. 20/42 we received the sum of \$50.00 from the B.C. Packers Ltd. in payment of a kitchen stove they had purchased from "S. ENDO". This sum was credited to Shin ENDO. However as it seemed to belong to Shigeharu rather than Shin, we wrote to both the brothers and have now received a reply from Shigeharu stating that the range was a McClary and was owned by him. We have therefore transferred the \$50.00 to the credit of Shigeharu.

There is no other property of any kind on this file.

There are no claims on file against Shin ENDO.

The sum of \$50.00 was received from the B.C. Packers Ltd. on Nov. 20/42 for a stove which they had purchased from "S. ENDO" of the Celtic Cannery. This sum was credited to Shin ENDO, Reg. No. 11776. Shin ENDO was a single man and declared no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area. His brother, Shigeharu ENDO was a married man and he also worked at the Celtic Cannery. Shigeharu ENDO did declare household goods at this Cannery. On February 25/47 we wrote to both the brothers asking which one of them owned this range. On March 6/47 we received a letter from Shigeharu ENDO stating that he was the owner of the range. Will you therefore please transfer these funds to the account of Shigeharu ENDO.
