We are in receipt of a letter from the above named policyholder advising us that he wishes to terminate this policy for its cash value. His address is given as c/o Henry Ully, R.R. #1, Barons, Alta.

If termination is proceeded with immediately we will be prepared to allow a cash surrender value of \$45.00, plus a dividend of \$3.50 making a gross value of \$48.50. Outstanding against this value, however, there is indebtedness which with accrued interest to May 3, amounts to \$37.25. Before proceeding with termination we would require the return of the policy contract to this office and an application for surrender form signed by the assured, or the Custodian in his stead.

We would appreciate knowing whether the Custodian consents to this transaction and if so, whether our cheque should be sent directly to the assured, or to the Custodian.


