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GENERAL SUMMARY

Yoshiye TAKASHIMA, Deceased

Reg. No. 06891

Yoshiye TAKASHIMA died in New Denver Sanitorium on October 5, 1943, at the age of 22 years. She is survived by her husband, Yoshitaka, file #8003, and two minor children.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian but, according to the Custodian Release on file, a considerable quantity of goods declared by her husband were shipped to her through the B. C. Security Commission at her request.

The only claim appearing on file is for the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses. The Commission was advised that the deceased had no assets but that her husband would have funds available in the future. The claim was, therefore, placed on Yoshitaka Takashima's file. When funds were available, the B. C. Security Commission was so advised but they requested this office to cancel their claim in a letter dated March 16, 1945.

No assets and no liabilities, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.

Yoshitaka TAKASHIMA - Reg. No. 96993.

The above named Japanese declared on his JP Form, signed 6th May, 1942, that he had no Personal or Trade Debt.

However, on 15th December, 1943, the B. C. Security Commission lodged a claim for the sum of \$80.00 to cover the cost of funeral expenses paid by the Commission in connection with the burial of Yoshiyo TAKASHIMA, File 6128, wife of Yoshitaka TAKASHIMA.

As Yoshitaka TAKASHIMA, at that time, had no funds, and when his property was sold to The Director, The Veterans' Land Act, we wrote as follows to The B. C. Security Commission, on March 14th, 1945 -

"Some time ago you lodged a claim of \$80.00 for funeral expenses in connection with the burial of the wife of the above named. We wish to inform you that he has at this time a credit balance of \$357.02, and we suggest that your Representative contact him and get him to authorize the payment of this claim, which we shall be glad to do on receipt of TAKASHIMA'S authorization."

and on March 16th, 1945, received the following reply -

"This will acknowledge your letter of March 14th with reference to our claim of \$80.00 for funeral expenses of the above. Please be advised that, in view of the financial circumstances of the husband and for other reasons, we do not now consider it advisable to press for payment of this account, and it is requested that you cancel our claim for same."

Thus cancelling the claim.

In reply to your letter of the 13th instant enclosing a list of the Japanese whose "JP" forms we did not send you.

We wish to report on each case as follows:

File #4716. Mrs. Masazo (Kofuji) MURAI. Reg. #07281. Personal property only was declared by this party and it has had both your attention and the attention of our Protection Department.

File #6569. Mrs. Yoshio (Jitsuko) MURAKAMI. Reg. #07360. Nothing but personal property was declared by this party and this matter has had the attention of both you and our Protection Department.

File #5996 Mrs. Nobushige (Tomo) YOSHIDA. Reg. #06975. This "JP" form was sent to you on May 5th last according to our records.

File #6128. Mrs. Yoshitaka (Yoshiye) TAKASHIMA. Reg. #06891. This party made declaration on our form "J" which is used in cases where evacuees have no property whatsoever to be left in the Protected Area. We note that the personal property of this woman is handled through the husband's file, #8003.

File #8003. Yoshitaka TAKASHIMA, Reg. #06880. The "JP" form in this instance was not sent to you as this man owns real estate in another district and the matter of personal property has been handled by you and it is not necessary to send you a copy of the "JP" form in this connection.
