





In reviewing his file it is noted that he declared funds to his credit in two of the New Westminster banks at the date of his registration, namely April 18th, 1942.

It would be advisable for you to consult a lawyer to assist you in that respect, or else write to Mr. J. H. Streight, Official Administrator at New Westminster.
