

CHATELS:

The above, in her declaration to the Custodian, dated April 21/42, stated that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area in British Columbia. However we did discover that she had left a sewing machine at 139 Garry Street, Steveston. Miss Kazue Mori, File No. 4975, declared five sewing machines at 139 Garry Street, Steveston. On March 25/43 two of these machines were shipped to Miss Mori. She acknowledged the receipt of these machines but advised us that one of them belonged to a friend and that she had shipped said machine to this friend. We wrote to Miss Mori on Nov. 26/45 asking for further particulars regarding this machine and the person she had shipped it to. In her reply dated Dec. 3/45 Miss Mori stated that the friend whose machine she had received along with her own, was Miss Chieko SHIMONO. We wrote to Miss SHIMONO under date of Dec. 7/45 asking her to confirm receipt of this machine from Miss Kazue MORI, which she did in her letter of Dec. 14/45.

The file does not reveal ownership of any specified articles by the above.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
