We are in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant requesting the shipment of a gasoline iron which you state was left in the attic of the house you lived in at Banfield.


You did not declare any such article to the Gustodian and consequently the field staff of our Protection Department could not make a special search for it as it did not appear in their records.
