(Bill of Sale from Hatakeyama to Tsuyako Takahashi, dated Dec. 8, 1941, is on boat file. Also letter from C. H. Hill, of RCMP, to the Registrar of Shipping, New Westminster, dated Jan. 20, 1942, advising that there appears to be no reason why the transaction should not be carried through; that is, the issuing of a licence to Tsuyako Takahashi.)

(The boat was, apparently, owned by Kohei TAGUCHI, File 8625, Japanese National, and Miss Takahashi authorized payment to him when the boat was sold.)

(TAGUCHI owed B.C. Packers more than the value of the vessel.)


