Dear Sir: Re: Claim of \$145.00.

With reference to the conversation the writer had with Miss Hation recently we were under the impression that this claim was against a Miss Kitaguchi, but we find it was against the sister-in-law of the above, namely Mrs. Kazuo HARAGA, nee Miss Sally KITAGUCHI. Mr. K. Haraga writes us in reply to our letter as to payment of your claims as follows:

"In the absence of my wife, who is in a nursing home, I am writing on her behalf. I confirm here the amount owing to Dr. Burwell is not Mrs. Tad Kitaguchi's (Reg.No.06171) but my wife's - Reg. No. 06172. At the time of operation she was still unmarried and working now and then. Her father had been unemployed prior to evacuation and after dispersal was shipped off to camp. We have been up against adversity since evacuation and my wife is in no condition to repay the debt occurred at that period due to such an unprecedented affair.

In view of the above I contend I cannot be held responsible for bills before our marriage."

Is there anything further, in the meantime, you would like us to do in this matter? If so, kindly advise.

The writer is endeavoring to trace an earlier letter of yours respecting other claims against Evacuees and will write you as soon as possible as to the possibility of obtaining these funds due to you.
