Replying to Mr. McAlister's letter to you of March 11, and with reference to his letter of January 14 to Mrs. Kobayashi regarding the following accounts, we have to-day interviewed Mrs. Kobayashi and her son Jun Kobayashi.

The outstanding accounts referred to are:

Dr. Bowles & Cragg	\$ 55.00

Mrs. Kobayashi acknowledges that the bills of Dr. Bowles Cragg, and R. Tagashira & Co. are for her account, and states that the amount due to the doctors is approximately \$55.00, but that that of R. Tagashira and Co. should not be more than a balance of \$50.00.

However, when she disposed of her business at 751 Front Street, New Westminster, she left all her papers there, and now, has no means of verifying the exact amounts.

At the present time Mrs. Kobayashi has no assets and is on maintenance in this town. She therefore, has no means of paying these accounts in the immediate future.

The two bills of the Royal Columbian Hospital are for the account of Jun Kobayashi, Reg. #08239, who resided at 806 Ewen Avenue, New Westminster, and who is the shoemaker in this camp. He cannot, at the present time, make any payment in cash due to the circumstances connected with the conduct of his business here. His position has been one which has necessitated his applying for relief for the past two or three months.

He is agreeable, however, to settlement of these accounts out of the proceeds of such assets as are at present in the Custodian's hands. These, we believe, consist mainly of household furniture.

We trust that this will clear up the matter, and enclose an extra copy of this letter for the Custodian's files.

Replying to your letter of the 22nd inst., we beg to say that we have made enquiry in regard to the full first name of the above, along with several other of his accounts requiring further particulars, but have received no reply as yet.

From Mr. Tagashira's ledgers which we have, there are several ledger pages for Mrs. H. Kobayashi, of 751 Front Street, New Westminster, as the only address in each instance. This account runs back several years and, as we pointed out in our last letter was active until March, last, with a balance still outstanding of \$124.23.

We would further point out that there are accounts for J. H. Kobayashi, of 202 Carroll st, and K. Kobayashi of Steveston, both of which are paid in full, and also one for Toyojiro Kobayashi, who was one of Mr. Tagashira's salesmen, whom, we believe, was interned. We have tried to get in touch with the latter, in regard to an accounting, on behalf of our client, and would be greatly obliged, if you have any information regarding him, you would advise us.

Reference is made to our letter to you dated December 15th under file No. 13578 in connection with claim made by your client of \$124.23 against a Mrs. T. Kobayashi. Thank you very much for your letter dated January 15th from which we observe that the account was apparently active, that the last delivery was made on March 14, 1943 (we presume this refers to March 14, 1942) and that the last payment of \$3.26 was made on March 25, 1942.

Would you please be good enough to advise us first as to the present amount outstanding and secondly as to the full name of Mrs. H. Kobayashi.

We are tentatively identifying this Japanese individual as Mrs. Hirokichi Kobayashi who resided at 806 Ewen Avenue, New Westminster, and not at 751 Front Street, New Westminster.

We have no record of any Mrs. Kobayashi of 751 Front Street, New Westminster, in our files save in connection with this particular claim, although evidence we have on file indicates that a Mrs. Toku Kobayashi may possibly at one time have resided at the address indicated.
